

Firm donates cash for poor family

A business house has donated cash to help the Huon family who lost their father, Paul Huon, in a car accident last month.

"We all have to lend a hand and this is one family we will continue to help in future.

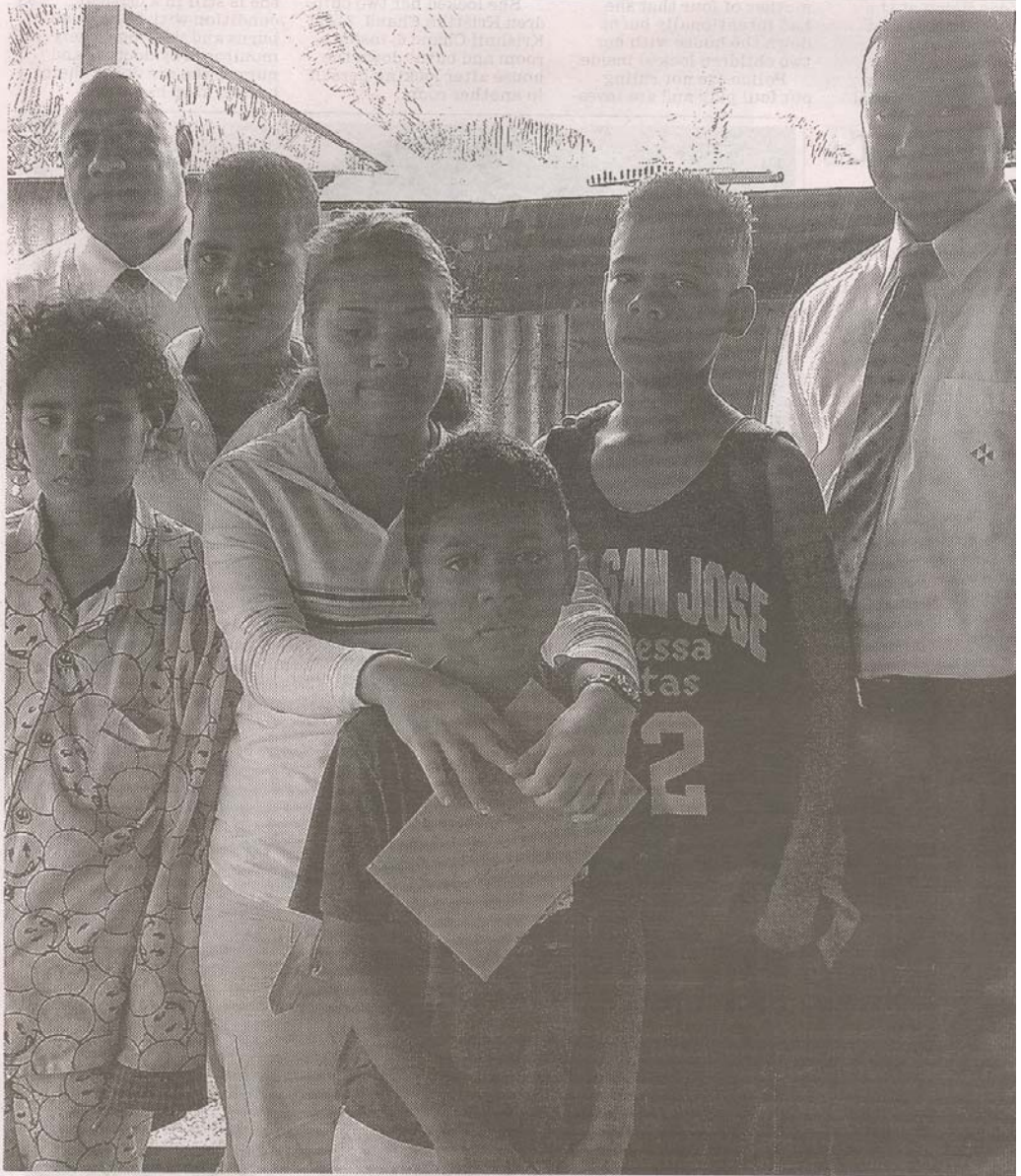
"We just donate some cash and we would like to inform other corporate communities to help. We also had a word with the family."
